- All entry forms must be mailed or emailed in by June 22nd, 2026 Attn: Home Arts, Rutgers Cooperative Extension 291 Morton Ave, Millville, NJ 08332, heatherco@cumberlandcountynj.gov.
- To ensure an easier registration process, **please submit all entry forms by June 22nd** Late entries will be accepted on the day of drop-off with a completed entry form.
- If there are changes to an entry form, please call 856-451-2800 (press 1) or email heatherco@cumberlandcountynj.gov.
- Bring entries to the Fair at 3301 Carmel Road, Millville, NJ 08332 4-H Building (Red Barn) on Monday, July 6th, between 4:00 and 7:00 PM. **Exception:** All food must be dropped off on Tuesday, July 7th between 9:00 and 11:00 AM.
- Any entries after 11:00 AM on Tuesday will not be judged and get a participant ribbon only. Judging will be Tuesday, July 7th after 11:00 AM.
- **No early pick ups.** All entries and awards will be displayed for the entire week.
- All entries must be picked up at the fairgrounds either between 8:00 PM and 9:00 PM, Saturday, July 11th or 9:00 AM and 12:00 PM, Sunday, July 12th. **No entries or awards removed before Saturday at 8:00 PM. All entries must be properly checked out.**
- If you cannot pick up by Sunday, July 12th by 12:00 PM please call 856-451-2800 (Press 1) or email heatherco@cumberlandcountynj.gov
- All classes are open to non-professional men and women.
- Age categories: Youth - 8 and under, 9 - 13, 14 - 18, Adult- 19+
- No entry fees will be charged.
- One entry per class. (unless noted otherwise)
- All entries must be the result of this past year's work.
- Each item entered must have an exhibitor's tag, given during registration.
- Every reasonable precaution is taken to protect entries while at the fairgrounds, but all entries are at risk of the exhibitor. No entries or awards are to be taken before Saturday at 7:00 PM.
- Judges' decisions are final. Each entry is judged on its own merit.

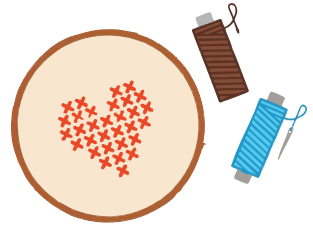

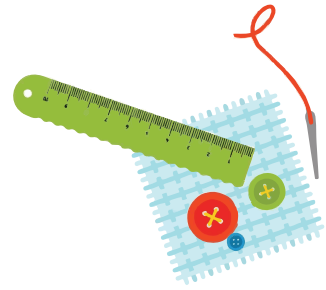

- The rest may be picked up after judging at 7:00- 8:00 PM on Tuesday, July 7th.
- All foods must be wrapped, cool before wrapping. Baked goods may be on paper plates. Be sure to put your name on bottom of pie tin or cake plate.
- Recipe should be included with all exhibits.
- No mixes may be used.
